According to Leonard et al. (1925), "The Ladson Mine is the most easterly mine in the Scranton Coal bed. It is in the SW corner of sec. 19, T.130N., R.97W., and the coal is mined by stripping off the overburden." Erickson and Merwin (1976) indicate that coal from this mine was not good grade coal. No SEBR or CMID listings were noted for a Ladson Mine, and no other mine-related information was noted in association with the legal location identified by this Planning Unit and AML location.
