Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

Although the Lind Coal Mine was licensed in 1910-1911, it began operations in about 1906. The mine was developed by John A. Lind, on land owned by his wife, Anna C. Lind. John A. Lind died in 1907, and his wife, Anna, maintained operation of the mine: John A. Lind's nephew superintended the mine from about 1907 through about 1919. In about 1920, Anna's sons (Alfred and Charles) obtained ownership of the land, and Alfred functioned as superintendent of the mine through 1936. The 1926 CMID indicates that "A fire has been burning in the old workings for a considerable time, concrete brattices have been erected, sealing off the fire area." Apparently no difficulties were experienced from the fire in the area of the mine that was being worked in 1926. The mine is listed "not operating" in 1936, and it appears likely that the mine ceased operations at about that time.
