It should be noted that the only source linking a mine name with this Planning Unit and AML location was the 1947 WCB map, which indicated that the "Trespass Mine" was located in T142N, R94W, Section 25, NW, SE. No listings were noted for a Trespass Mine in the CMID; however, Christ Heinert is listed as the owner/operator of the Trespass Mine on the WCB map, and Christ Heinert is listed as the superintendent of the Heinert Mine in the CMID. Therefore, it has been assumed that the Trespass Mine and the Heinert Coal Mine are the same mine, and data about the Heinert Coal Mine has been included with this Planning Unit and AML location.
