The Walforth Coal Mine is listed as a new strip mine in 1931, and Rudolph Dietz is listed as superintendent; from 1932 through 1934, the Dietz Coal Mine is listed, with Rudolph Dietz as superintendent (see Notes, below). No listings were noted following 1934; it is not known if the mine ceased operations or if it ceased reporting.

Harrington (1934a) indicates that this mine was located at T134N, R88W, Section 8; however, no part section is provided. Therefore, it is not known if this mine was located at this Planning Unit and AML location, or if it was situated in some other portion of Section 8.

No information was noted that definitely relates the Walforth Coal Mine with the Dietz Coal Mine; however, since both mines were superintended by Rudolph Dietz, it has been assumed that the names Walforth Coal Mine and Dietz Coal Mine refer to the same mine.
