This mine is listed as a new mine in 1923. The mine reported continuously from 1923 through 1940; it is not listed as closed or not operating in 1940 and it may have been operated following that year, but not reported.

Notes:

This mine should not be confused with the Havelock Coal Mine, located at T135N, R96W, Section 27, NE (part of which is identified by Planning Unit 026, AML location 31).

Sources containing information pertinent to the Havelock Quality Coal Co. (Harrington 1934a, Gauger 1928a) located this mine at T135N, R96W, Section 28; however, neither source provided a part section. The 1926 CMID indicates that this mine was located 0.25 mi. south of the community of Havelock, which would place the mine somewhere in the southern half of Section 28. Two Planning Unit and AML locations (Planning Unit 026, AML locations 28 and 29) include portions of the south half of Section 28; therefore, this mine has been included with both Planning Unit and AML locations.

Havelock Quality Coal Co. (continued)

The Havelock Coal Co. (aka Havelock Fuel Co.) also is located in the south half of Section 28 (Planning Unit 026, AML locations 28 and 29).

The New England Coal Co. also may be located at Planning Unit 026, AML location 28 or 29.
