Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

Leonard et al. (1925) indicate that "An old stripping pit exposes 6 feet of weathered lignite near the center of the north line of sec. 36, T. 145 N., R. 83 W." Smith (1910) indicates that "Pfister & Cramer are mining a bed of lignite by stripping" at T145N, R83W, Section 36, NE, at the Pfister & Cramer Mine. No reports for a Pfister & Cramer mine were noted in SEBR or CMID reports; it appears that this mine was in operation prior to inclusion of coal production statistics in SEBRs (about 1909). How long before or after 1910 this mine was in operation is not known; however, Leonard et al. (1925) do refer to "an old stripping pit," so the Pfister & Cramer Mine apparently ceased operation some time prior to 1925.
