Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

Heinemeyer (1932) indicates that C.J. Dolan opened a mine, which was located on what became the Jacob Reichenberg farm, in 1884. This mine was partly stripped and then undermined, but it caved in in 1885, and Dolan moved his operation. No additional information was noted about a Dolan Mine or a mine superintended, owned, or operated by Dolan.

Notes:

The Reichenberg Coal Mine and Hazen Coal Mine also are located at this Planning Unit and AML location.

It should be noted that Heinemeyer (1932) provides no legal location for the C.J. Dolan mine, but indicates that it was located on what became the Jacob Reichenberg farm. It is possible that Reichenberg's farm consisted only of T144N, R86W, Section 8, NW; however, Reichenberg's property may have extended beyond this quarter-section. If such is the case, C.J. Dolan's mine may not have been located in Section 8, NW, and the mine would not have been situated at Planning Unit 064, AML location 157.
