This mine is listed as a new mine in 1949. The mine is listed in 1949, 1950, and 1951; however, no listings were noted following 1951 and the mine is not listed as closed or not operating in 1951 or 1952. Brant (1953) does indicate that the Beick drift mine was located in T144N, R88, Section 4; however, it is not known when Brant may have done work in the area. Therefore, it is not known if the Beick Coal Mine ceased operations following 1951, or if it was operated and not reported following that time.
