The John Garber mine is listed as a new strip mine in 1923. No listing was noted for 1924, and the Garber Coal Mine is listed as a slope mine from 1925 through 1927, when the mine is listed "closed." No listings were noted for this mine following 1927, and it is likely that the mine permanently ceased operations in that year.
