This mine is listed as a new mine in the 1926 CMID, and it is listed as closed in the 1927 CMID. No listings were noted following 1927. The Renville County History (1976) indicates that the coal from this mine was wet and that it had to be dried out. This source also indicates that "In 1930, the mine had been abandoned and Roy Cole was hired to fill the hole. Roy, as part of the fill, drove a steam engine into the opening. . ."
