Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

This mine is not listed as a new mine in 1909, and reference is made to this mine in Babcock (1901); how many years prior to 1901 the mine was operated is not known. The 1910 SEBR indicates that the Missouri Slope Company mine is the name applied to a small mine conducted by the Dickinson Brick Company." Most other sources refer to this mine as the Dickinson Brick Company mine or the Dickinson Fire & Pressed Brick Company Mine. The 1910 SEBR indicates that in the summer time the coal is taken to the brick company's yard and in the winter is sold to the local trade. The mine [situated on the banks of the Heart River] is flooded by the spring high waters, and as the coal dips away from the outcrop, it has to be pumped out after the river has gone down." The 1912 SEBR indicates that this mine was "operated in 1908 and 1909 and was closed during 1910 and 1911." No listings were noted following that in the 1912 SEBR, and it appears likely that the mine ceased operations following about 1909.
