Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

This mine is listed as a new mine in 1935. The mine was operated as a drift mine and reported as the New Murray (aka Murry) mine from 1935 through 1938. The 1939 CMID lists a Heizelman Mine, and indicates that a "new slope" had been developed at the mine (see Notes, below). The Heizelman Mine was operated as a slope mine and reported continuously from 1939 through 1942, when it is listed as not operating. No listings were noted for the mine(s) following 1942; it is not known if the mine ceased to be operated, if it was operated but not reported, or if it was operated and reported under some other name following 1942.

Notes:

No information was noted that indicated that the New Murray Coal Mine became the Heizelman Mine; however, Herbert Heizelman was the superintendent of the New Murray Mine from 1935 through 1938 and of the Heizelman Mine from 1939 through 1942. Additionally, the New Murray Coal Mine is not listed closed or not operating in 1938 and the Heizelman Mine is not listed as a new mine in 1939. Therefore, it has been assumed that the two mine names refer to the same mine.

The Buckholz and Wyman/Wagner/Nelson coal mines also are located and the Faul and Hanchette coal mines also may be located at this Planning Unit and AML location.
