This mine is not listed as a new mine in 1909, and it may have been in operation prior to that time. The mine was located in a coulee that "runs into the Mouse River valley a short distance below the town of Burlington. There is no water in the mine whatsoever." The 1912 SEBR indicates that the main entry of the mine extended 200 ft., and rooms were 100 ft. by 16 ft. The 1914 SEBR indicates that the Scotty Coal Mine was "operating in 1910-1911 and closed in 1912-1913." No further listings were noted for the mine.
