Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

This mine is not listed as a new mine in 1917, and it may have been in operation prior to that time. The 1918 SEBR and Leonard et al. (1925) indicate that the mine was open only in winter. Leonard et al. (1925) also indicates that the mine was opened by a drift into the "side hill at the outcrop of the Hanks (coal] bed, which is here some 70 feet above the bottom of the valley, thus allowing ample fall for gravity tipples to wagons. No machines or electrical equipment are used but all coal is mined by hand and hauled by horses or mules to the tipple." The mine was operated and reported in 1919; the 1920 CMID indicates that the mine was not in operation. No listings were noted for this mine following 1920. Although it is likely that the mine was not operated following 1920, it is possible that the mine continued to be operated but was not reported, or that the mine was operated and reported under some other name following that year.
