This mine is not listed as a new mine in 1920, and it may have been in operation prior to that time. The mine was operated from 1920 through 1935; the 1920 CMID indicates that the entry had caved sometime in 1919, but that the problem had been attended to by 1920. The mine is listed closed in the 1935 CMID, and no further listings were noted for it. It is likely that the mine ceased to be operated following 1935; however, it also is possible that the mine was operated but not reported or that it was operated and reported under some other name following 1935.
