Although this mine is not listed as a new mine in 1921, the 1921 CMID indicates that "This is a small mine, prospecting being done, but was condemned on account of ventilation." Since only prospecting was being in 1921, it appears likely that this mine had not been in operation for long, if at all, prior to 1921. The 1926 CMID indicates that "At the time of inspection the main entry was caved 70 feet from the entrance." This cave-in apparently was repaired or a new entry driven, since the mine continued to be operated and reported from 1927 through 1936. Although the mine is not listed closed or not operating in 1936, no listings were noted following that year. It is not known if the mine ceased to be operated, if it was operated but not reported, or if it was operated and reported under some other name following 1936.
