This mine "was opened in December, 1917." By early 1918, the main entry of the mine was 73 ft. long, and rooms were 70 ft. by 16 ft. No further listings were noted for this mine; however, a WCB map dated 1924 was noted. It is not known if the mine ceased to be operated, if it was operated and not reported, or if it was operated and reported under some other name following 1917.
