

BONSNES COAL MINE.

The Bonsnes Coal Mine, owned by O. E. Bonsnes, is situated three and one-half miles south of Stampede. The coal bed is from four to five feet thick and the mine is operated as a surface mine. About nine feet of clay has to be removed before the coal is exposed. Some water is encountered which is removed by a tank pump. This mine was opened in the fall of 1917 and supplies only a small local demand. It was inspected March 7, 1918.
