Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

The Anderson Coal Mine is listed as a new mine in 1912. No report was noted for the Anderson Coal Mine from 1916 through 1922, and the mine is listed as a new mine in 1923. In 1927, the mine is listed closed, and it is assumed that the mine ceased operation in about that year. No explanation is provided for the lack of reports from 1916 through 1922; the mine may not have been in operation or the mine may have been in operation but not reporting.

Notes:

A discrepancy exists between SEBR (1914, 1916) and the 1923 WCB map. The SEBR documents list the Anderson Coal Mine in T142N, R79W, Section 23, SE; the WCB map (1923) lists the A.F. Anderson Coal Mine in T142N, R79W, Section 23, NE. It is possible that the mine opened in 1923 was located in Section 23, NE and that the mine operated from 1912 through 1915 was located in Section 23, SE. It also is possible that the mine had extended into Section 23, NE by 1923.
