The Baukol-Noonan Coal Mine also is located in part at this Planning Unit and AML location. location 319--T162N, R95W, Section 10). The Baukol-Noonan Coal Mine, which apparently began operations at T162N, R95W, Sections 11 and 10, expanded to include portions of Sections 1, 2, 3, and 12.

Site 32DV11, which records the Baukol-Noonan Coal Mine, includes the area in which the Parker Mine was located.
