Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

A 1926 WCB map (updated to 1933) indicates that a strip pit was operated by the Northwest Improvement Co. (Northern Pacific Railroad) at T134N, R91W, Section 13, W1/2 under a lease. According to these maps, this mine was operated by Reinhart Sprecher. Leonard et al. (1925) indicate that "A short drift mine has been opened in this same [coal] bed in the SW1/4 of sec. 13, T.134N., R.91W." No SEBR or CMID listings or other data were noted for a Northwest Improvement Co., Northern Pacific Railroad, or Reinhart Sprecher mine, and no other named mines were noted in association with this Planning Unit and AML location.
