Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

This mine is not listed as a new mine in 1916, and it likely was in operation prior to that time; the 1918 SEBR indicates that "some underground mining has been done in previous years, but this method has been abandoned." The mine is not listed as closed in 1917, but no further listings were noted for a Culver mine until 1935. The Culver Coal Mine listed in 1935 is not listed as a new mine; however, no information was noted that would definitely indicate that the Culver Mine reported in 1916 and 1917 and the Culver Mine listed from 1935 through 1941 are the same mine. Leonard et al. (1925) and Harrington (1934a) do mention a Culver Mine that apparently was in operation in about 1925 and 1934. Leonard et al. (1925) indicate that the Culver Mine operated in T134N, R97W, Section 14, SW, but Harrington (1934a) indicates only that the Culver Mine was located in T134N, R97W, Section 14 (i.e., no part section. The Culver Mine is listed as "not operating" in 1941. Since no further listings are noted for the Culver Mine following 1941, it is possible that the mine ceased operations following that year; however, it also is possible that the mine ceased reporting following 1941.
