This mine is not listed as a new mine in 1914, and it may have been in operation prior to that time. Listings were noted for this mine only for 1914 and 1915, and Leonard et al. (1925) refer to the coal bed "formerly mined in sec. 22." However, the 1916 SEBR indicates that this mine supplied coal to the power plant of the Krem Roller Mills. It is possible that the mine was operated following 1915, but not reported. If this is the case, it is not known for how long the mine was in operation following 1915, but Krem was an active community until the late 1920s or early 1930s.
