

The Mannhaven Mercantile Company owns a mine near Mannhaven, in Township 146, Range 84, Section 7. The seam here mined, which is visible along the river for a mile and a half, is five feet above summer water level at its southern end, while it touches the water farther north. Its thickness is seven feet and the quality of the coal is reported as good. The mine is directly on the river and is worked during each winter, the amount of lignite taken out annually amounting to about 1,000 tons. Above the lignite lies a sandy clay.(This mine appears to be located in T146N R85W Sec. 12 SE (BAJ))
