Discrepancies were noted in legal locations listed for the White Ash Coal Mine:

SEBR:1910. T158N, R86W, Section 28
SEBR:1918. T158N, R86W, Section 26, SW
WCB:1924. T158N, R86W, Section 28, SW

The 1910 SEBR and 1924 WCB map indicate that the mine was situated at T158N, R86W, Section 28, and the 1924 WCB map also indicates that it was situated in Section 28, SW. The 1918 SEBR, however, indicates that the mine was situated at T158N, R86W, Section 26, SW, which is not identified by any Planning Unit or AML location. The 1910 SEBR also indicates that the mine was situated "about five miles up the Des Lacs River valley from Carpio," while the 1918 SEBR indicates that the mine was situated "four and one-half miles northwest of Carpio." Both of these descriptive locations appear more likely to refer to Section 28 than to Section 26, and it is likely that the section listed in the 1918 SEBR is in error; however, no information was noted to clarify this locational discrepancy definitely.
