This mine is listed as a new mine in 1936. The mine was operated and reported continuously from 1936 through 1942, when it is listed as not operating. It is not known if this mine ceased operations following 1942, if it was operated but not reported, or if it was operated and reported under some other name.

Notes:

It should be noted that the 1937 WCB map associating a mine with this Planning unit and AML location names the mine the "Carl Johnson Farm Strip Mine." The only listings noted in CMID reports during the general time period of 1937 that include the name "Johnson" were listed "Johnson Coal Mine," C.A.P. Johnson Coal Mine," or "Johnson, C.A.P. Mine." Since the Johnson mine listed in CMID reports was a strip mine, the legal location provided on the WCB map is in reasonable proximity to the community of Taylor, North Dakota (the post office listed for the mine in CMID reports), and the "C." in "C.A.P." conceivably could refer to "Carl," it has been assumed that the Johnson/C.A.P. Johnson mine listed in CMID reports is the Carl Johnson Farm Strip Mine referred to on the 1937 WCB map.
