Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

This mine is not listed as a new mine in 1933, and it may have been in operation prior to that time. No production figures are listed for the mine in the 1933 and 1934 CMID reports; however, the Summary of Inspection in both reports indicates that the mine was using "machine mining" to obtain coal from the mine. It is not clear why production figures are not provided in 1933 and 1934; it is possible that the mine was opened in about 1933 and that only development work was conducted in 1933 and 1934, but no definite information was noted. The mine was operated and reported continuously from 1935 through 1946; no listings were noted following 1946. It is not known if the mine ceased operations or if it was operated and not reported following 1946. It should be noted that production had decreased significantly by 1946, which may indicate that the mine ceased to operate following that year.
