Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

This mine was opened in the fall of 1916. A steam pump was used to remove water found in the mine, and in March 1918, the "air course was found almost closed by a cave-in and the ventilation was slow." No listings were noted for this mine following those in the 1918 SEBR; it is not known if the mine ceased to be operated, if it was operated but not reported, or if it was operated and reported under some other name following 1918.
