Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

This mine is not listed as a new mine in 1909, and it may have been in operation prior to that time. A different system of mining was used at this mine, as indicated in the 1910 SEBR: "The room neck is driven in about a hundred feet and then is widened out to a width of thirty feet, and the work brought back toward the entry. This is in effect a sort of retreating long wall. The wall being thirty feet long, with the roadway in the middle and at right angles to it." According to the 1912 SEBR, "This mine is nearly worked out. It is intended to open a new drift another summer." This report also indicates that the main entry of the mine extended 1,000 ft. The 1914 SEBR indicates that the Ingeson Coal mine was "operating in 1910-1911 and closed in 1912-1913."
