This mine is not listed as a new mine in 1931, and it may have been in operation prior to that time. The Holland Coal Mine apparently was operated from 1932 through 1934; the 1935 CMID indicates that the Powell Coal Mine was "Formerly Holland Mine." The Powell Coal mine was operated from 1935 through 1942; the 1942 CMID Summary of Inspection indicates that the Holland Coal Mine was "Formerly Powell Mine." The Holland Coal Mine was operated from 1943 through 1952; no listings were noted following 1952. It is not known if the mine ceased to be operated, if it was operated but not reported, or if the mine was operated and reported under some other name following 1952.

The 1938 WCB map that illustrates this mine indicates that it was located at T153N, R100W, Section 9, Lot 5. Generally, Lot 5 would be located in the SW of the NW; however, the map appears to indicate that the situation of the mine was in Section 9, NE. Therefore, since other references containing information about this mine do not include a part section for the mine, this mine has been included as possibly located at this Planning Unit and AML location.
