Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

A 1924 WCB map indicates that the Barney Hole Mine was located at T154N, R98W, Section 11, NW. A listing was noted for this mine in the 1923 CMID, which indicates that the mine was a drift mine; however, the 1923 CMID does not provide production statistics for the mine. Wonder of Williams (1976) indicates that Barney Holl (aka Hole, Hall) advertised his mine in various local functions; however, no listings were noted for the mine following that in the 1923 CMID. It is not known if the mine ceased to be operated, if it was operated but not reported, or if it was operated and reported under some other name following 1923.
