Basic Data (excerpted from primary sources):

This mine is not listed as a new mine in 1912, and it may have been in operation prior to that time. The 1914 SEBR indicates that the main entry of the mine extended 300 ft., and rooms were 200 ft. by 16 ft. to 18 ft. Also according to the 1914 SEBR, "Well water, which occurs at a depth of about 30 feet, is said to be good for steam purposes." The 1916 SEBR indicates that the main entry of the mine extended 400 ft., and that no water was encountered in the mine. The main entry of the mine extended 500 ft. by early 1918. The mine was operated and reported in 1919; the 1920 CMID indicates that there was no report for this mine and that it was "not in operation." No listings were noted for this mine following 1920; it is not known if the mine ceased to be operated, if it was operated but not reported, or if it was operated and reported under some other name following 1920.
